## Canadian Association of Nursing Research (CANR) and CNSA Joint Award



### Introduction

The Canadian Association of Nursing Research and CNSA Joint Award of \$1000 is awarded to one student in their second year or higher in a Canadian nursing degree program. Students are invited to submit an Abstract for a paper presentation which will be reviewed by a scientific review committee. The successful student will present their paper (research or non-research based) at the CNSA National Conference.

### Criteria

- The award is open to nursing students registered in a nursing school with current membership in the CNSA.
- The candidate must be a student in their SECOND YEAR OR HIGHER of a nursing program.
- The candidate must be able to attend and present their paper at the CNSA National Conference in January.
- The candidate is responsible for all travel costs to the conference. The candidate can apply for financial assistance from CNSA to assist with the travel costs, but is still required to attend the conference regardless of whether any financial assistance is granted or not. Failure to attend the conference would result in loss of the award.
- The candidate must successfully complete the academic year in which the application is made.
- Current members of the CNSA Board of Directors are not eligible for the award in their year of office.

The CNSA Awards Committee will choose 3 (three) successful applications for consideration for the **Canadian Association of Nursing Research (CANR) and CNSA Joint Award**. Only the successful applicant(s) will be notified via mail.

**Call for Abstracts**

1. Abstracts may be submitted in English or French. Please indicate the language of presentation, however no simultaneous translation service will be provided.
2. Research abstracts should include the following information: rationale, problem, methodology, findings and implications. Please indicate in the abstract if the research is in-progress.
3. Project or clinical initiative abstracts should include the following information: description of the project or clinical issue/experience, purpose, goals, method of implementation, results, and implications or recommendations for change or improvement of the project/experience. Please indicate in the abstract if the project or initiative is in-progress.
4. The entire abstract, including title, name(s) of the presenter(s), and text must fit within the box provided.
5. If the abstract reports on a project or study that is not the student's original work, acknowledgement must be provided indicating the involvement of others who may have contributed substantially to the project or study. However, the student should have prepared the abstracts themselves to a large extent. Other contributors should be listed as co-authors.
6. The text should be single-spaced and not exceed 250 words.
7. At the time of abstract approval, further information will be required on audiovisual equipment and other requirements. Applicants will be notified in an email by December 1.
8. All abstracts submitted for this competition will be reviewed by a Scientific Review Committee comprised of a student and a nursing leader using the following criteria: the relevance to the theme of the conference, writing quality, significance of topic, research-base, and implications for nursing practice, education, research or administration.
9. The successful abstract will be presented at the annual CNSA National Conference held in

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January.

10. The presentation is to be 10 minutes in length followed by opportunity for discussion for 5 minutes.
11. The successful candidate will be presented with the monetary prize and a certificate during the Awards Banquet at the conference.
12. The presenter is expected to register for the conference and is responsible for all travel costs to the conference. The candidate can apply for financial assistance from CNSA to assist with the travel costs, but is still required to attend the conference regardless of whether any financial assistance is granted or not. Failure to attend the conference will result in loss of the award.
